WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION:

Use Shelley's favorite Stitch + Flip techniques to make these dreamy, mosaic-inspired nine-patch blocks for a truly stunning quilt ... made simply!

This three hour workshop will only focus on piecing the block, itself. With some additional fabric, students can also opt to follow the instructions in the book to piece a 60" x 75" quilt at a later date.

PATTERN INFORMATION:

A copy of Shelley's *Aurora* quilt pattern is required to participate in this class. No dimensions or cutting instructions will be provided during instruction. Patterns can be obtained at www.CorasQuilts.com/patterns/aurora.

PLEASE NOTE:

Each student should provide their own fabric, supplies, and copy of the book. These items will not be provided as part of the course fee.

FABRIC SELECTION:

For my sample quilt, I used a rainbow of bright colors, selecting a dark and a light print to use in each block. My sample uses a dark grey unifying print for the center stars and diamonds against a white solid background.

If you're new to the stitch-and-flip methods, I recommend working with scrap fabric in class to practice the techniques, before sewing with the fabric for your "actual" project.

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The cover quilt features prints from Shelley's Spring Song fabric collection for Contempo Fabrics by Benartex.


Materials:

- 1 Fat Quarter Bundle of Spring Song prints (FQSPSPK), with:
 - 10 Assorted Medium + Dark Prints (10371-80, 10372-86, 10372-80, 10374-82, 10374-26, 10375-42, 10375-26, 10375-55, 10376-43, 10376-82)
 - 7 Assorted Light + Low Volume Prints (10371-08, 10372-01, 10372-08, 10373-08, 10373-82, 10373-86, 10374-08)
- Fabric 1 - 1 1/4 yards - Honeycomb in Dawn (13076-13)
- Fabric 2 - 2 1/4 yards - Superior Solids in White (3000B-09)
- Fabric 3 - 3/4 yard for binding - Honeycomb in Midnight (10376-11)
- Batting - 68" x 83" piece
- Backing - 4 3/4 yards

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PREPARING FOR YOUR CLASS:

- Students should come to class with the fabric for at least one to two block(s) starched (if desired), cut, and ready to sew.
- Backing fabric, batting, and binding fabric will be needed to finish a whole quilt, but don't need to be brought to class.

REQUIRED SUPPLIES:

- Sewing machine + spare needles, neutral-colored thread, seam ripper, thread scissors, iron, pressing mat
- Small square rotary ruler (+/- 6" x 6") with diagonal lines marked, rotary cutter with sharp blade, and cutting mat.
- Pins and fabric scissors
- Water soluble fabric marker or other temporary marking tool.

RECOMMENDED SUPPLIES:

- Washable glue stick
- Painter's tape or 1/4" seam tape for machine bed
- Wool pressing mat, tailor's clapper, non-starch-based pressing spray
