Here are some of the products that I have found useful as there has been some interest in exactly which things I use.

#### Interfacings

Lightweight – Pellon P44F Fusible Interfacing \*I use this for 90% of the items.

Midweight – Pellon 911FF Fusible Interfacing

Woven – Pellon SF101 Shape-Flex

Two-sided fusible for patches – Pellon 805 Wonder-Under

#### Steam Press

I own the Singer Steam Press ESP2 Singer Intelligent Steam Press 26 and have been very happy with them. Any basic steam press will work though!

#### Needles

Domestic Machine (I have an older Bernina) – Schmetz Jersey 80/12

Longarm Machine (I have a 50-year old Quilt King) – Groz-Beckert 110/16 or 110/18 - 134 FG/SUK

#### Batting

Quilter's Dream Select Weight Poly
