Supply List

Class Description: The beautiful designs achieved in this class are created by the fabric. Select a large print with high contrast (examples are shown in the book, *Stack & Cut Hexagon Quilts*.) The method for stacking the fabric, how to cut the shapes, and selecting the serendipitous designs are covered with a sample project and the beginnings of a larger project. Confident beginners to experienced quilters will all enjoy the creative opportunities from these designs.

Tools & Notions:

- Basic Machine Sewing Kit (includes machine, scissors, thread, machine needles, wound bobbins, seam ripper)
- Doll needle or long, large needle
- Rotary Cutter, Ruler & Mat
- 60° ruler, recommend Clearview Triangle 8" or 10" or the Super 60 - available at class.
- The book, "Stack & Cut Hexagon Quilts" - available at class.
- Otools Cutting Edge, Sewing Edge, Corner Cut – optional, highly recommended.
- 2' x 3' piece of flannel or batting for a design wall - optional



Preparation Prior to Class:

To prepare for the class, I recommend watching the video on Serendipity Designs on my website: <https://quiltwithmarcibaker.com/serendipity-stacking/>

Two light, one medium, and one dark $\frac{1}{4}$ yd each, fat quarter is fine, of fabric to match stacked fabric provided in class. Sample fabric will be made available closer to workshop date based on number of students.

For your own project: A large print with high contrast fabric with 6 repeat sections. Depending on repeat size, this can be anywhere from 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ yds to 4 yds. Bring a couple of fabrics if not sure which to use. This will be stacked and ready for cutting your own project later, after class.
